Connecticut Valley Litho Club Scholarship selection Guidelines

- 1. The C.V.L.C. Scholarship will be awarded for undergraduate studies (B.A., B.S., and a two year Assoc.) in the Graphic Arts and or Computer Communications.
- 2. First priority is a relative of a CVLC member who has been in good standing for two years, second priority is a non-CVLC relative who lives in the geographic Connecticut area.
- 3. If no one qualifies, the scholarship will be held in abeyance until the next year.
- 4. A cut-off date for review of applications is May 31.
- 5. To apply as either a new applicant or a continuing applicant, the student must provide the committee proof of acceptance or proof of attendance and continuance plus their most recent transcript of grades. For new applicants the grades must include their complete high school and/or college records.
- 6. High school applicant rating and selection guidelines:
 - a. Overall grade average will be a minimum of a "C".
 - b. Student should have a well rounded list of extracurricular activities.
 - c. Highest rating to be given to the best blend of high grades and extracurricular activities.
 - d. Since the committee has no vehicle for financial needs, the committee's perception of this factor must play a minor role in the selection process.
- 7. College applicant rating and selection guidelines:
 - a. Priority will be given to a current recipient for continuance rather than to a new applicant.
 - b. To quality for continuance, a student must be in good standing. Good standing is defined by the committee as the following minimum cumulative QPA levels:

Freshman	2.20
Sophomore	2.30
Junior	2.40
Senior	2.50

Good standing is further defined as being free from any disciplinary probation.
